



2018 Off-Road Cup Details!

Sign Up - All RACERS need to come to Sign Up to sign waivers, pick up your packets (contains your team “baton”, number plate decals, rules, stickers & rider giveaway) & get your transponders programmed! This works best when all members of the team are together! Go to the FLY easy up first & then to the red scoring trailer. BRING YOUR HELMETS! If you need a transponder, bring \$10! We will open Sign Up by 1pm on Friday and stay open until 10pm or there’s no one left standing around! We will open again on Saturday by 6:30am until 7:30am. Please keep in mind that we have to start the race at 8am Saturday to keep everything on time! It is very important that you come to Sign Up ASAP when you arrive on site! We will not hold up the start of the event just for you!

Pit Area – The “PITS” are in a fenced off area & there will be absolutely NO trucks, vans, trailers, or cars allowed in there at any time! You may use a SxS or ATV to transport your stuff into the pits (before and after the race, not during). Each entry has been given a 10 foot wide “stall” where rider exchanges and gas stops will take place & it will be designated with your team/rider pit sign (your sign is at the beginning of your stall). There are 3 pit lanes and they are organized first by class and then by series. Do NOT move pit signs to change your pit area - they are set up where they are for a reason.

Practice – There is NONE! Absolutely NO pre-riding! You can walk the track and/or ride your mountain bike, but there are NO motorcycle tracks of any sort allowed on the course before the race (this includes pit vehicles)!

Facility – Gates will be open starting on Thursday. You can camp Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights! The Panther Creek staff will handle all parking. The RV sites are reserved for people who planned accordingly. Panther Creek has an additional parking plan in place if needed - just follow along with the guidance of the PC staff, please & thank you! Race Track – Track is 10.5 miles & a mixture of new trails & established trails...typical gravely & rocky Missouri stuff. A track map is posted at the bottom of this document.

Riders Meeting(s) – Friday at 7pm and Saturday at 7am near the scoring trailer...please attend to ensure that you/your teammates know what’s up.

Other – It is the rider’s responsibility to ensure that their pit crews & spectators know the rules at this event!!!! Failure to comply with the rules and with official staff could result in docking laps, etc.

****ALL** pets must be kept on a leash & at your vehicle in the parking area – NO pets allowed in the pit area, at the start, or anywhere near the race track!!!! This has been a problem in years’ past, let’s not make it one this year!**

All-You-Can-Eat spaghetti supper Friday night in the dining hall for \$10 (5:30-7:30ish). Concessions available all day Saturday - including breakfast starting at 6:30. There is also a shower house on site. Also note that cell service can be VERY spotty at this venue, so plan accordingly.

Trackside Supply will have their parts trailer there on Friday & Saturday for all your weekend parts needs!

Custom Outfitters will also be on site with their custom trailer for you to tour/check out.


Directions –

From Tuscumbia, head South on Hwy 17 for about 5 miles to State Rd A. Turn left onto State Rd A and go 4 miles. Turn left on Humphrey Creek Rd (gravel) and then go 1 mile. Race entrance on the left.

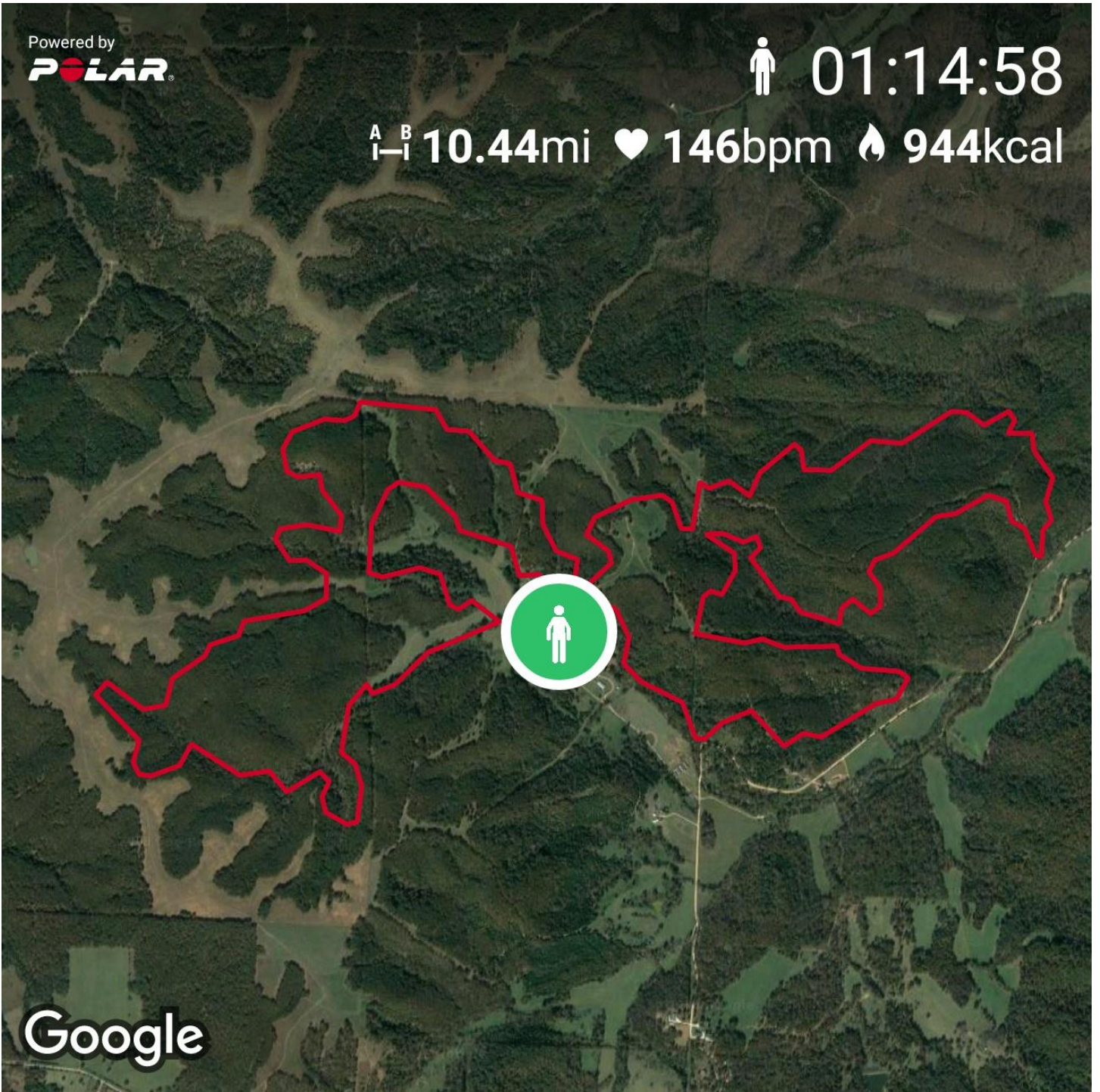
