Golden City, MO - Midwest Off Road Events LLC (MORE) officially announced that registration for the 9th Annual Off-Road Cup will open on March 1st, 2019 and there will be a 350 rider limit. The event will take place Saturday, April 20th, 2019 at D-Day Adventure Park near Wyandotte, OK.

The 9-hour 3-man team event is designed to pit series against series to determine which off-road racing series in America can put together the fastest, toughest, most consistent 3-rider team. With 11 team classes and 4 Ironman/woman classes to choose from, all skill levels are encouraged to compete for their series. Riders will be allowed to ride their own bikes and all racing will take place during daylight hours.

D-Day Adventure Park is home to the World's Largest Paintball Event and its' central US location, approximately 30 minutes southwest of Joplin, MO makes it an excellent venue for the 2019 running of The Off-Road Cup.

The website will be updated daily to show how many spots have been filled. Registration will close on March 31st OR on the date that we meet the 350 rider mark.
